

**Gate 21**  
**Lower Suwannee Refuge**  
**Riverine Floodplain, Sandfly Creek**

- Trailhead:** Gate 21 on Lower Suwannee Nature Drive  
6.1 miles from South Entrance; 3.1 miles from North Entrance  
GPS: ?, ?
- Parking:** On cleared right of way in any area that does not block gate
- Length:** .8 miles round trip
- Loop:** No
- Handicap accessible:** No
- Conditions:** Trail consists mainly of old logging road that is kept cleared. Mostly shaded and likely wet.
- Sights:** Birds, wildflowers, butterflies, wildlife, riverine floodplain ecosystem, scenic Sandfly Creek.
- Highlights:** Easy, but often soggy, walk through riverine floodplain ending at edge of scenic Sandfly Creek.
- Connections:** Kayak/canoe on Sandfly Creek after portage on trail.
